

iPAD RESTRICTIONS

How to enable restrictions so that the App Store and Account Settings are unavailable without a special access code

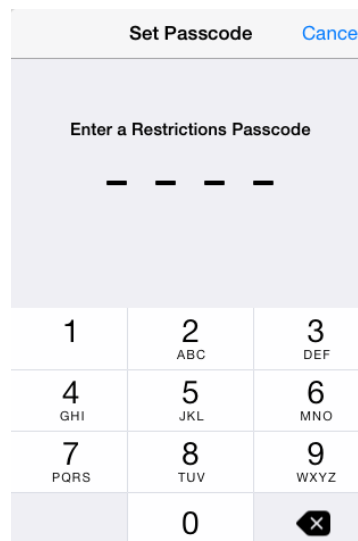
STEP ONE: Decide on a 4-digit parental restriction code and decide how you will document and secure this code. If it gets lost, the only option is to wipe out the iPad data and reinstall.

STEP TWO: If you are going to disable any accounts like email or iMessage, disable the accounts FIRST before you turn off access to the account settings.

STEP THREE: Enable restrictions using a four digit pass code. Tap on SETTINGS and then GENERAL. Scroll down to RESTRICTIONS and tap it. Then tap ENABLE RESTRICTIONS.



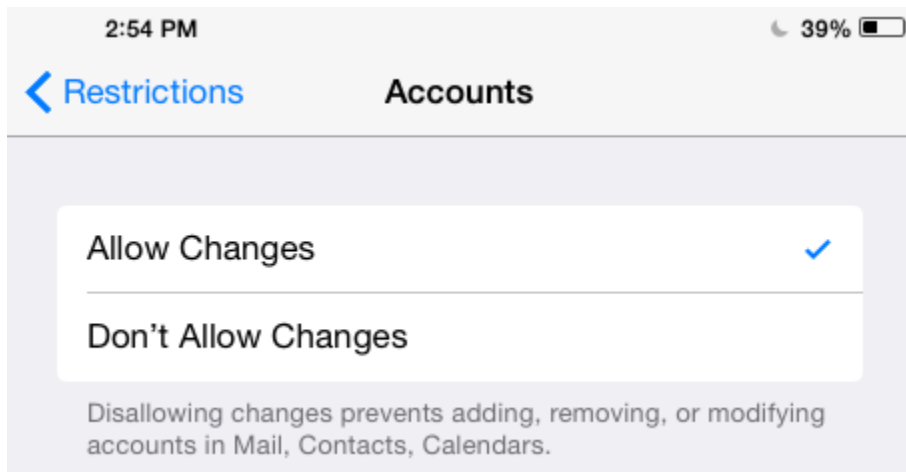
Type in your four digit code two times:



De-select the options (as desired) for “Installing Apps” “Deleting Apps” and “In-App Purchases”



Scroll further down to the section entitled “Allow Changes.” Tap on ACCOUNTS. Under this section, tap on “Don’t Allow Changes.”



You will now need the new restrictions code to change back any of these settings and to access the restrictions section to make changes.
